

SCHEDULE TOU-G

SMALL COMMERCIAL TIME-OF-USE SERVICE

AVAILABILITY:

This Schedule is closed to new enrollments effective October 31, 2022. Service under this Schedule will terminate 90 days after permanent small commercial TOU rates become effective. Applicable to general light and/or power loads less than or equal to 5,000 kWh per month, and less than or equal to 25 kW, and supplied through a single meter. For customers who exceed 5,000 kWh per month or 25 kW of demand three times in a twelve-month period, a demand time-of-use meter will be installed and the customer's billing will be transferred to Schedule TOU-J at the beginning of the next billing period.

Service will be delivered at secondary voltages as specified by the Company, except where the nature or location of the customer's load makes delivery at secondary voltage impractical, the Company may, at its option, deliver the service at a nominal primary voltage as specified by the Company.

TIME-OF-USE RATING PERIODS:

The time-of-use rating periods shall be as follows:

On Peak:	5:00 p.m. - 10:00 p.m., Daily
Mid-Day:	9:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m., Daily
Off-Peak:	10:00 p.m. - 9:00 a.m., Daily

DETERMINATION OF TIME-OF-USE ENERGY:

The Company shall install, own, operate and maintain a time-of-use meter to measure the customer's kWh energy consumption during the time-of-use rating periods.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- 1) The Company may meter the customer's energy usage pattern for one to three months before the customer's service start date under this Schedule, to allow the Company to gather the customer's baseline load profile.
- 2) The Company shall install the time-of-use meter in accordance with Rule 14. Although the existing service equipment is expected to be used, the customer shall provide, install, and maintain the service equipment specified in Rule 14, such as all the conductors, service switches, meter socket, meter panel, and other similar devices required for service connection and meter installations on the customer's premises.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS - continued:

- 3) A customer may terminate service under this rate Schedule and return to the regular Schedule G at any time without penalty, by a written notice to the Company. The change shall become effective at the start of the next regular billing period following the date of receipt by the Company of the notice from the customer. If a customer elects to discontinue service under this Schedule, the customer will not be permitted to return to this Schedule for a period of one year.

Surcharges, Clauses, and Fees:

All rates and charges applicable to this rate schedule from surcharges, clauses, and fees approved by the Commission shall be included in the customer bill, including those from the Energy Cost Recovery Clause, Purchased Power Adjustment Clause, Revenue Balancing Account Provision, Integrated Resource Planning Cost Recovery Provision, Public Benefits Fund Surcharge, and Green Infrastructure Fee Surcharge.

Rules and Regulations:

Service supplied under this rate shall be subject to the Rules and Regulations of the Company.
