

# Property Owner/Manager Request for Whole-Building Energy-Usage Data



The City and County of Honolulu (City) established the Better Buildings Benchmarking Program to advance Honolulu’s goal of carbon neutrality by 2045. This program is in accordance with Ordinance 22-17, which Mayor Blangiardi signed into law July 20, 2022. In 2023, property owners/managers of commercial and multifamily buildings larger than 100,000 square feet, are required to track and report their buildings’ 2022 annual energy-use data to the City by June 30, 2023.
